- ❑ Your coaches packet will be available for pick up at your first game by the scores table. Games start no earlier than 4PM Friday and conclude late afternoon on Saturday
- ❑ Teams are guaranteed 3 games unless scheduling dictates otherwise
- ❑ Individual awards for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd or Consolation depending on bracket size.

Rules and Regulations: *Additional rule sheet will follow in coach's packet.

SDHAA basketball rules will be used with the following exceptions:

1. All games will play two 18 - minute halves with running clock. Clock will stop only for player injury and time outs. The clock will stop on all whistles during last one minute of the game unless one team has a lead of 15 points or more.
 2. 3rd and 4th grade divisions NO PRESS allowed during games.
 3. 5th and 6th grade divisions NO PRESS until the final two minutes of the game. No press if 10 point lead.
 4. 7th - 8th grade divisions no Press when ahead by 10 points or more.
 5. Three-Point rule applies on courts where there is a line marked.
 6. Zone defense is illegal in the 3rd - 7th grades, only man – to - man defense is allowed. 8th grade divisions may play zone.
 7. Each team will be allotted 3 time outs per games, and one additional for each overtime.
 8. Overtime periods will be 2 minutes.
 9. Half time is 5 minutes in length.
 10. Games will start early if both teams agree.
 11. Players must play on only 1 team. Players may play up a grade level, but may not play down.
- Each team must be prepared to provide a game ball, scorer or timer if necessary.**
A team may be suspended from further play for un-sportsmanlike conduct by its players, coaches, team managers or fans.
