

Corporate Cup 2010 Blood Drive Challenge!

Blood Drive Dates: February 1st through April 9th 2010



In keeping with the spirit of the Corporate Cup motto 'to promote health for all', the Mayor's Council will again be having our Corporate Cup Blood Drive. Last year hundreds of people participated in this event and we would like to encourage more of you to participate this year.

***NEW for 2010:** The reason for adding the Blood Drive segment to the Corporate Cup challenge a few years ago, was to encourage additional donations to United Blood Services, above what they were taking in each year. To make sure that is still the goal, the following policy will be strictly enforced this year with no exceptions. **Points will be awarded for those who give blood ONLY during the corporate cup blood drive dates of February 1st and April 9th 2010.**

Just A Reminder of the some changes we made in the past couple years!

- ❑ Your corporation can "recruit" anyone to donate blood for your team! They do not have to be an employee or a spouse. When they give blood, they must tell the UBS employee what team they are donating for. We will not allow you to come back at a later date and say that certain people are donating for your team. **THEY MUST** specify the team upon donation.
- ❑ The point value for 2BRC is 30 points. The point value for each successful "regular" donation will be 20 points, with a team maximum of 500 points.

As a Team Captain, here's all you have to do:

1. We ask that you make all employees aware of their opportunity to donate blood or recruit someone to donate blood and earn points for your Corporate Cup team.
2. Have anyone who wants to donate blood call United Blood Services (225-7732) to set up a time. If you have any questions regarding a blood donation please feel free to contact any of the staff at UBS. Sara is the new director at USB is you have any specific questions.
3. When an individual goes in to donate blood for your team, it is **their responsibility** to indicate what team they are donating for. The UBS staff will then write them down at the end of their *successful* contribution. Again, we will not retroactively assign an individual's donations towards your team total.
4. At United Blood Services, blood can be donated once every 8 weeks, we **will** allow individuals to give more than once and be counted towards the team total during the blood drive dates.
5. Businesses that have two or more teams participating in the Corporate Cup event **will have the total number of bonus points split evenly between each team.**
6. The Council will confirm the totals from UBS after the April 9th deadline.
7. Results will be posted at the Corporate Cup competition on April 15th.
