HISTORY OF OUR YMCA

- In 1926, the Aberdeen Family YMCA first opened its doors to the community.
- For 40 years, the YMCA has operated childcare centers for infants through 6th graders.
- The YMCA has operated after school programming (today known as Uproar) for almost 30 years.
- In conjunction with the community, the YMCA and the Northeast Regional Health and Fitness Center completed a successful campaign to build a new YMCA facility which opened its doors in 2005.
- In 2013, the YMCA's Youth Development Center (YDC) opened its doors to the community.

RECOGNIZE THE NEED FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Over the past decade the Aberdeen community has seen steady growth and this brings a need to support a vibrant and vital community through recruitment of employees to support business development and youth development. Recently there has been an increased recognition for the value of childcare for both employers and employees. The Minneapolis Federal Reserve study found that childcare availability is holding parents back, especially mothers, from reentering the workforce. A recent state-wide report found that thousands of childcare slots were lost in South Dakota due to the pandemic. The childcare challenges are made even more evident with the ever growing waitlist at the YDC.

Project related information:

- Aberdeen has grown 8.2% since the original YDC campaign. Reliable and high quality childcare is an essential part of the employment infrastructure for both attracting new employees and retaining them in the workforce.
- There is a current unmet need for childcare. the greatest need being infant and toddler care.
- 74% of families in South Dakota have both parents working outside the home creating the crucial need for quality childcare.
- Almost three fourths of working parents report that their work has been affected by childcare issues in some regard.
- There is a role for existing and new businesses to support a new expanded childcare center.
- Financing through private and public sources would accomplish this expansion of childcare.

THE YMCA'S POSITION

As a charitable community service organization, the Aberdeen Family YMCA fills various needs in the community when we are called upon. The Youth Development Center has been operational for 9 years as of March of 2022, and is the largest childcare center in Northeastern South Dakota. In order for our region to continue growing, quality youth development must continue to be prioritized. Our YMCA offers youth development as a central component of our mission and we are well positioned to lead an expanded YDC project to continue serving our community.

OUR PLAN

- Construct a 10,562 square foot expansion to our current Youth Development Center adding 8 additional classrooms.
- The Youth Development Center is currently licensed to accommodate 255 children. The addition will be licensed to accommodate an additional 145 children ages 4 weeks to 5 years.

• Increase full-time employees by 20 at the YDC.





CAMPAIGN GOAL

\$3,500,000

The goal of the Aberdeen Family YMCA in conjunction with the Aberdeen community is to raise \$3,500,000 to fund the facility addition and related costs.

PRELIMINARY TIMETABLE

The campaign will end in March 2023 with construction beginning shortly after. The addition will be occupied in March 2024.
